Following a career in the UK military, he worked in NATO on non-military threats to security and as a consultant to the European Commission, where he focused on a similar range of issues. On leaving government service, he worked as an independent consultant to a range of bodies including the US Government, the European Space Agency and in the private sector.

He helped design and create the new AI initiative in Hungary which began in 2017 – the AI Forum, Hungary. The aim and objective of this new project was to further understand AI issues and its impact on public policy. A particular focus of this activity included medical AI and public health, law enforcement and security, the impact of AI and emergent technology and the underlying philosophy of AI. In 2019, The Centre for the Study of New Security Challenges (UK) signed a partnership agreement with NUPS to further AI awareness and education within the university.
